Key Verse: 1 Corinthians 3:16 "Do you not know that you are the temple of God and that the Spirit of God dwells in you?"

**Kev Truth:** Every Christian needs to know, understand, appreciate, and experience the Person and work of the Holy Spirit in

his life.

The Holy Spirit is not an abstract influence or just a powerful force. He is a Divine Person and we need to reverence, respect, honor, and treat Him as one.

#### The Holy Spirit is a Real Person.

He is not a white cloud.

He is not a mystical force.

He is not tongues.

He is not a white dove flying in the sky.

He is the THIRD PERSON of the Godhead.

The Bible opens and closes with the Person and work of the Holy Spirit.

Genesis 1:2; Revelation 22:17

#### THE PERSONALITY OF THE HOLY SPIRIT

John 14:16

"And I will pray the Father, and He will give you another Comforter, that He may abide with you forever."

When Jesus said, "He will send another comforter", making reference to the Person of the Holy Spirit, that meant that Jesus Himself was a comforter, helper, paraklete.

Jesus was saying, "I will send someone to you, 'another comforter', someone just like Me."

The Holy Spirit was given the special responsibility of:

- (1) taking the place of Jesus on the earth.
- (2) revealing and showing Jesus to the world.

(3) demonstrating and doing the works that Jesus did (i.e., the continuation of His Ministry).

In John, Chapters 14, 15, and 16, the Holy Spirit is called "Parakletos" by Jesus, meaning ...

- (1) COMFORTER, (2) STANDBY, (3) ADVOCATE, (4) INTERCESSOR,
- (5) TEACHER, (6) FRIEND, (7) GUIDE, (8) COUNSELOR,
- (9) STRENGTHENER, (10) LEADER, (11) HELPER, (12) PARTNER.

**REMEMBER:** The Holy Spirit could not have taken the place of the Person of Jesus and relate personally to the disciples unless He was a living Person.

The Holy Spirit has the qualities of a Person.

He has a mind. Romans 8:27

He has a will. 1 Corinthians 12:11

He has emotions. Romans 15:30

He speaks. Acts 13:2

He bears witness and testifies. John 15:26; Romans 8:16

He instructs. Nehemiah 9:20

He prays and makes intercession. Romans 8:26

The Holy Spirit has the feelings of a Person.

He can be grieved. Ephesians 4:30

He can be insulted. Hebrews 10:29

He can be lied to. Acts 5:3

He can be blasphemed. Matthew 12:31, 32

He can be resisted.

The Holy Spirit is a Divine Person indwelling the Christian, and working within him to fulfill the will of God.

One of the greatest needs of the church today is to understand and possess a personal relationship with the THIRD PERSON of the trinity - God, the Holy Spirit.

It is not enough just to talk about Him, or learn more information about Him, but we must become acquainted with the Holy Spirit and really know Him.

The Holy Spirit is God, and He is a real living Person. He is pictured in scripture as a Person separate and distinct from both the Father and the Son.

#### **BLASPHEMY AGAINST THE HOLY SPIRIT**

Matthew 12:30-32

**Matthew 12:31** 

"Therefore I say to you, every sin and blasphemy will be forgiven men, but the blasphemy against the Spirit will not be forgiven men."

#### Blasphemy means ...

- 1. to speak evil of Him.
- 2. to rail and abuse Him.
- 3. to revile and speak profanely against Him.
- 4. to speak words that will insult and injure Him.

5. to slander and accuse Him falsely.

The Father and the Son have decided that the Holy Spirit is so special and important that BLASPHEMY against the Person of the Holy Spirit HAS NO FORGIVENESS.

Blasphemy is INSULTING God and the work of the Holy Spirit willfully - Ananias and Sapphira blasphemed the Holy Spirit in Acts 5. In Matthew 12, the Pharisees attributed the work of the Holy Spirit to the devil.

### SYMBOLS OF THE HOLY SPIRIT

The scriptures picture the Person and work of the Holy Spirit using different symbols.

#### 1. WATER

John 7:38, 39; Isaiah 44:3

The Spirit symbolized as water speaks of the LIFE-GIVING flow which refreshes, renews, and satisfies. It also speaks of washing, cleansing, purifying, and fruitfulness.

Ezekiel 47:9

"And it shall be that every living thing that moves, wherever the rivers go, will live. There will be a very great multitude of fish, because these waters go there; for they will be healed, and everything will live wherever the river goes."

#### 2. FIRE

Matthew 3:11; Isaiah 4:4; Acts 2:3

This symbolizes the Holiness of God and the work of the Holy Spirit burning out all the wood, hay, and stubble of sin, and compromise from our lives. The Spirit of Burning will not only purge, purify, and remove all the dross from our lives, but He will burn into us a fervent zeal to serve the Lord.

### 3. WIND OR BREATH

Acts 2:2; John 3:8; Job 32:8

This reveals the life-giving breath of God bringing NEW LIFE, REVIVAL, RENEWAL, and INSPIRATION. It speaks of the Holy Spirit who is invisible as a Person, yet the powerful effects of His work are evident.

4. OIL

Psalm 23:5; Psalm 92:10 Luke 4:18; Acts 10:38

This speaks of the anointing abilities of the Holy Spirit who calls, equips, gifts, and enables believers to function in their ministry in the Church.

#### 5. THE DOVE

Matthew 3:16; Luke 3:22

The symbol of the dove speaks of the Holy Spirit's nature of purity, peace, beauty, and gentleness. Like a dove, the Holy Spirit is very sensitive and can be easily hurt.

#### 6. THE FINGER OF GOD

Luke 11:20; Matthew 12:28

This represents the power of the Holy Spirit to pinpoint, touch, and minister to the needs of people in the specific areas where they have problems. The finger of God in action expels demons, sets the captives free, and brings conviction of sin to the lost.

"But you shall receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you shall be witnesses to Me in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth."

G. You can't cast out demons without the Holy Spirit anointing you.

**Matthew 12:28** 

"But if I cast out demons by the Spirit of God, surely the kingdom of God has come upon you."

H. You can't have joy without the Holy Spirit working within you.

**Romans 14:17** 

"For the kingdom of God is not food and drink, but righteousness and peace and joy in the Holy Spirit."

1. You can't have victory over the flesh without the strength and help of the Holy Spirit.

Galatians 5:16

"I say then: Walk in the Spirit, and you shall not fulfill the lust of the flesh."
